Proposed E.on Longfield Tarn Wind Farm

It was good news to learn that E.on was not going to pursue planning for the Longfield Tarn site. However, the wording of their official notification on their website, which was the same as the letter sent to the Parish Council, opens up the possibility of a smaller developer looking towards developing the site on a smaller scale. The Parish Council would welcome your views.

Rural Broadband

Tim Farron MP, along with many Hutton Roof residents, attended the last Parish Council Meeting in order to watch a rural broadband presentation by NEXTGENUS. Thank you to all who attended.

The next full Parish Council Meeting will be held sometime during the second/third week in November. However, there will be further village meetings about rural broadband sometime in the near future.

Kirkby Lonsdale First Responders now have a kit dedicated to Hutton Roof and enough resident First Responders to have cover in the village most of the time, the group also covers Kirkby Lonsdale and up to Barbon, Whittington and Lupton with volunteers in all areas. The First Responders are a group of local volunteers who are contacted by the ambulance service to provide initial emergency support with oxygen and a defibrillator, for someone who has collapsed or may be having a heart attack, until the ambulance arrives on the scene. The volunteers are trained, supported and insured by the Ambulance Service. The group is currently recruiting so if you would like to find out more please contact the co-ordinator Debbie Hodgkiss on 71955. Don't miss the Heart Start course with David Read on 18th November at the village hall.

NEW ROOF NEWS

We have received confirmation of a total of £8050 (over 60%) in grants for the village hall roof so far. We also hope to get a contribution from the council via Councillor Roger Bingham in the next few weeks. Planning permission is in progress and work will start ASAP.
